What is a Makerspace?

A Makerspace is a place where people can come together to use, and learn to use, materials as well as develop creative projects. Makerspaces promote learning through play and are places that can be used for a range of activities with flexible learning goals and creative purposes. The Creative Geelong MakerSpace will provide access via subscriptions and programs to a range of tools and equipment for designing and creating, using devices such as 3D printers, a laser etcher, soldering irons, an industrial sewing machine and over locker, as well as a range of electronics (Raspberry Pi, Arduino).

Subscriptions (GST inclusive)

- Annual adult subscription: \$575pp
- Annual student subscription: \$375pp
- Access cards: \$50 for five sessions
- Corporate subscriptions (negotiable)

Subscriptions are contingent on successfully completing an induction process and agreeing to the MakerSpace Code of Conduct. MakerSpace availability subject to key personnel. Materials charged extra.



Programs (subject to change)

- After school sessions – 15-18 years. Supervised access to work on design & technology projects.
- Soldering Sessions (2 hours) from \$30pp
- Raspberry Pi / Arduino 101 (2 hours, two sessions) from \$100pp
- Tinkering Teachers Time – sessions for teachers to engage with industry practitioners on digital and makerspace technology
- Practical 3D Printing – a range of programs to create personal objects with 3D printers i.e. jewellery, keyrings, decorative miniatures and kitchen gadgets
- Build your own 3D Printer – from \$850pp
